WHEREAS, General Peay's service to VMI has therefore gone largely unrecognized, unappreciated and ignored; and

WHEREAS, General Peay deserves to be honored by VMI for the invaluable contributions he made and the relentless dedication to excellence he fostered at VMI; THEREFORE,

**BE IT KNOWN** that, those attending the 60<sup>th</sup> Reunion of the Class of 1961, UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED that General Peay be honored in a demonstrable fashion by the Board of Visitors of VMI, the VMI Alumni Association and those others who should accept the mantle of doing so for his unequalled service to VMI and through it to VMI, the Commonwealth of Virginia and the nation and that this Resolution be appropriately circulated so its message is widely received by the VMI community; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that General Peay is hereby nominated by us to receive the New Market Award from the Board of Visitors and the Distinguished Service Award from the VMI Foundation.
